Meeting called to order by Kelly Dodge.

Introductions were conducted and June Minutes were approved. 1st- Bill 2- Phil

Update on new office space: Kelly shared that the realtor for the Pizza Ranch wants quite a bit more morn that we can afford, the office space committee will meet with the owner to see if we can work something out. A suggestion was made by Britt that we look at Monticello City Hall another suggestion was made tot look at the old motorcycle museum

Board Elections will be conducted in September. The Secretary position and the Vice President will be up for election at that meeting. We will also conduct a formal vote for John Klein (currently Vice President) to become president at that meeting (base on the by-laws)

Carryover

The carryover request was approved by our project officer for DFC grant. This funds 2 people attending Underage Drinking Enforcement Training Center conference in August and increased enforcement at the fair.

Mid Year Conference

We do not have anyone interested in attending the Mid Year conference this year, so we will have approximately \$2912 to spend before September 30. A possible idea is funding Jones County youth to attend the Take Charge Conference. More discussion will take place at next coalition meeting.

Jones County Fair- The group will have a table at the fair. The timeslots are full, but we can always add more people if anyone else is interested in covering the booth.

Underage Drinking Enforcement Training Center is in August. Six students and 2 adults will travel to the training in Anaheim California. A motion was made that we add 1 adult to attend using some of the money from the Mid-Year conference if travel arrangements were possible. The motion was made by John and Seconded by Britt. The motion passed unanimously.

National Night Out is August 3rd. Events will be conducted in Wyoming, Monticello and Anamosa and are being planning by community leaders and interested citizens. The coalition plans to have a booth and some information available at each night. The coalition voted unanimously to provide \$100 to each event for marketing of the event pending approval of advertising by the marketing committee.

Sub-Committee Updates:

Assessment Committee

- Social Host survey at the fair with a daily drawing
- Midland and Kirkwood assessments were completed this spring and are being tabulated. Hoping to do school assessments in Anamosa and Monticello next year.

Marketing Committee

- Group has been working on marketing items for the fair including a new brochure and display items. The group hopes to have promotional items to distribute as well

Policy Update

- The sub-committee has reviewed the social host ordinances of other communities and will be drafting a sample policy this summer.

Special Events

- Fair and National Night Out are the focus of the special event committee right now.
